Environmental Testing

Mold accrues through water damage, excess humidity and lack of ventilation. We will inspect every area, looking for excess moisture, condensation or potential leaks.

If mold is visible, our inspector will sit down with you to discuss the findings, the remediation techniques best suited for your particular needs, the time it will take and the cost involved.

If mold is not visible, air samples will be taken to determine what types of mold are present and at what levels. We offer two types of mold sampling – swabs and air sampling.

Radon is a colorless, odorless radioactive gas. It is created by the decay of uranium and is present in all rock and soil. According to the Surgeon General, Radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer. Radon causes thousands of preventable deaths each year.

A high Radon test does not mean that a home is uninhabitable or undesirable; it simply means that the high levels should be lowered. Professionally installed removal (often called 'mitigation') systems can lower Radon to an acceptable level.
